
Overall Results as of January 18, 2024 **Goals –** 25 % participation and \$4.5 Million

Parish Participation Goals for 2024

How are parish participation goals determined?

- 1. The Pastors Advisory Committee approved parish participation goals and a Diocesan-wide goal of 25% goal.
- 2. The 2024 goals reflect a 3.5% increase from last year's final participation rates.
- 3. All parishes at or below 21% participation in 2023 will have a goal of 24.5%, the base rate for the 2024 Appeal.
- 4. All parishes with 22%+ participation in 2023 will have a goal increase of 3.5% for 2024.

Each parish is asked to make a "good faith" effort to implement the Appeal plan as described in the Campaign Guide.

WEEK #1 Pre-Announcement Weekend

January 27-28

(Parishes display posters and announce the Appeal in bulletins and at pulpit)

WEEK #2 Announcement Weekend

February 3-4

(Present lay witness testimony and Pastors to promote stewardship in their homilies)

WEEK #3 Commitment Weekend

February 10-11

(Video message from Bishop is shown and in-pew commitment process used at every mass)

WEEK #4 Follow-up Weekend

February 17-18

(Follow-up process for all who have yet to fill out a pledge envelope)

Preparing for Announcement Weekend February 3-4, 2024

- Pastor should prepare a homily that touches on a stewardship message.
- Theme of this year's BASA is:
 - We are the Hands of Jesus
- Work with your pastor to provide lay witness testimonies at the end of Mass, or the time when announcements are made.

Why Promote Stewardship through the Homily and Lay Witness Testimony?

- It's about tangibly helping others and positively impacting peoples lives throughout our diocese.
- Practicing stewardship transforms parish communities.
- Many do not have a holistic understanding of stewardship.
- Stewardship enhances community outreach and involvement.
- Stewardship, as a way of life, changes one's perspective.
- Embracing stewardship brings individuals and families closer to Christ.

2024 Pre-Planning

By answering the following questions, as they specifically relate to your parish, you can adapt the corresponding Appeal communications and processes accordingly:

- Are you livestreaming Masses?
- How are you regularly communicating with parishioners?
- Any new channels of communication?
- Which entrances/exits are parishioners currently using during Mass?
- Do you have greeters/ushers available at each Mass?
- What kind of audio-visual equipment do you have available to share the BASA video?

Preparing for Commitment Weekend

- Check your box of BASA materials as soon as it arrives to ensure everything is there. Please notify our office, (904) 262-2600, ext. 160 right away if anything is missing.
- Test the downloaded BASA video in the exact way it will be set up on Commitment Weekend.
- Meet with the volunteer team and ushers to communicate the in-pew process and responsibilities that are specific to your parish.
- Schedule sorting/mailing team for the Monday following commitment weekend (February 12, 2024).
- BASA envelopes should be treated with the same care as parish offertory and should not be opened.

Your FedEx box(es) of BASA materials includes:

- Scheduled to ship to all parishes on January 19th.
- In-pew Envelopes in both English and Spanish (for parishes that have Spanish Masses)
- Pre-printed parishioner labels to be applied to all donor completed in-pew envelopes
- Stewardship Prayer Cards
- Prayer Request Cards
- English/Spanish BASA Brochures
- Pencils (if requested on forms returned to DOSA)
- Parish Summary Report Forms (3 ply form)
- Pre-addressed, pre-paid FedEx labels, and envelopes



BASA Video Important Change for 2024



- No DVD's will be duplicated and mailed to parishes as in previous years.
- An email with the link to the Vimeo site will be provided to all parish pastors, admin staff and BASA coordinators NLT January 26th with instructions on how to download.
- The English and Spanish videos can be downloaded from the Vimeo site, saved to a computer and flash drive.
 - English video is approximately 5 GB
 - Spanish video is approximately 6 GB
- After downloading video, be sure to test on audio/visual equipment that will be used at Masses for In-Pew Sunday to ensure all works OK.
- Recommend downloading at least the 1080p file.
 - (The higher the pixel count, the higher the quality of the video)

A/V Equipment

- Ensure that you have the necessary A/V equipment in place prior to each Mass.
- Identify and prepare the person designated to run the equipment/ troubleshoot for each Mass.
- If you are livestreaming Mass, please refer your parishioners joining you from home to the video that has been posted to the Diocese of St. Augustine's website. This will be a much better option for them to view the video.

Commitment Weekend - Follow the Process!

- **Pastors** should lead the in-pew process at each Mass.
- Before Mass begins, ushers/greeters should be provided enough in-pew envelopes and pencils to distribute to parishioners as they enter the church.
- After the Gospel has been proclaimed, **pastor** introduces Appeal, then shares Bishop's message via the 2024 BASA video.
- When video or pastor in-pew pledge instruction is complete, all pledge envelopes are sealed and collected per the specific parish plan.
- Count and mail team meets Monday morning (2/12/24) to sort and mail package (use provided FedEx envelopes with appropriate reporting sheet).

Pledge Envelope

Two ways to give:

- 1. In person collection basket or drop off at parish office
- 2. Online DOSA website or scan QR code with smartphone

Back of Envelope

Why the In-Pew Envelope and Process is Important

- 1. Invites all to participate through gifts and prayers.
- 2. Engages parishioners that regularly attend your parish but are not registered.
- 3. Response determines follow-up by the diocese.

Processing Responses

1. Processing Envelopes the Monday after <u>Commitment Weekend</u> and <u>Follow-Up Weekend</u> –

- BASA envelopes should be treated with the same care as parish offertory, kept on parish grounds in a secure location.
- All envelopes will be sorted into one of four Categories and rubber banded together:
 - 1. I/we *have already* made a gift to the Appeal,
 - o 2. I/we *will* make a gift to the Appeal,
 - o 3. I/we am *not able to* make a gift to the Appeal,
 - 4. All other envelopes: unidentified, no information, or direct mail pledge cards
- Affix matching labels provided to each in-pew envelope *if all information does not match, DO NOT place the label on the envelope.*
- If loose cash is received in the collection, place all cash in a plain white envelope and write "Parish Name/Anonymous" along with the amount, and place in Category 4.
- Under no circumstances should an in-pew or direct mail envelope be unsealed
- After all envelopes have been placed in a Category, fill out the Parish Summary Report:
 - o Place top copy (white) in <u>each</u> of the provided FedEx envelopes with in-pew envelopes
 - Send/fax/email middle copy (yellow) to the Diocese
 - Keep the bottom copy (pink) for your records

Please rubber-band each category separately before placing in your FedEx envelopes along with the corresponding reporting sheet.

Complete Parish Summary Report

- Fill out all information
- Count of each category noted
- Include top copy (white) with the pledge envelopes sent to processor via FedEx
